

## Crash of a TAAG Angola Airlines B-737



On June 28, 2007, at 1:40 p.m., a TAAG Angolan Airlines B737-2M2, crashed on landing at the airport in M'Banza Congo, northern Angola. There were 6 crew and 78 passengers on board.

According to the **Plane crash info. Site**, the aircraft blew two tires on landing, causing one wing to dip and touch the runway. The plane then veered out of control, overran the runway and crashed into cars and a building. Four passengers and the copilot were killed.

The same day the European Union had announced the blacklisting of the airline and barred it from flying into its airspace due to safety concerns.
